More than 150 participants joined last year, gaining access to research and solutions that are directly influencing how care is delivered in communities across Nova Scotia.

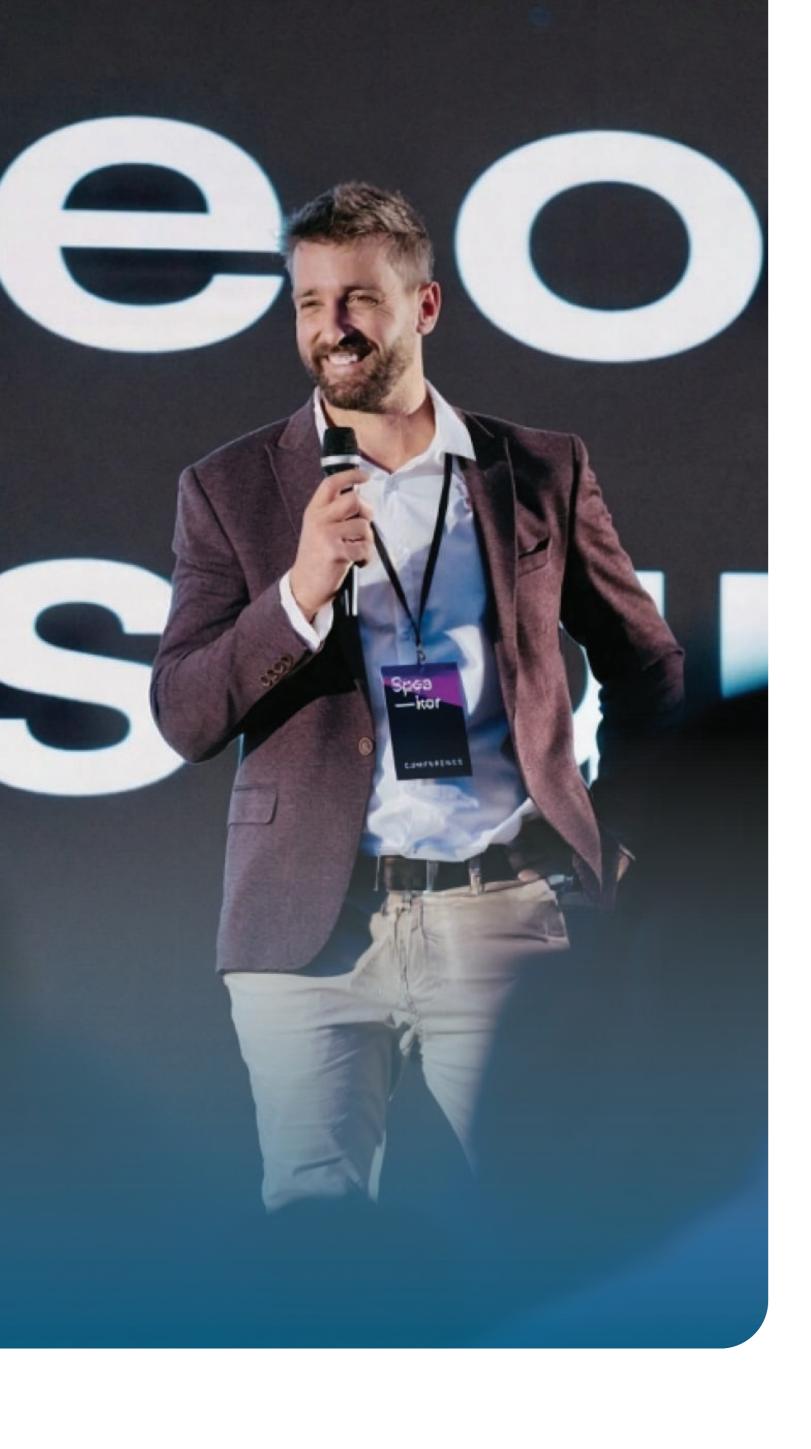
WHY IT MATTERS

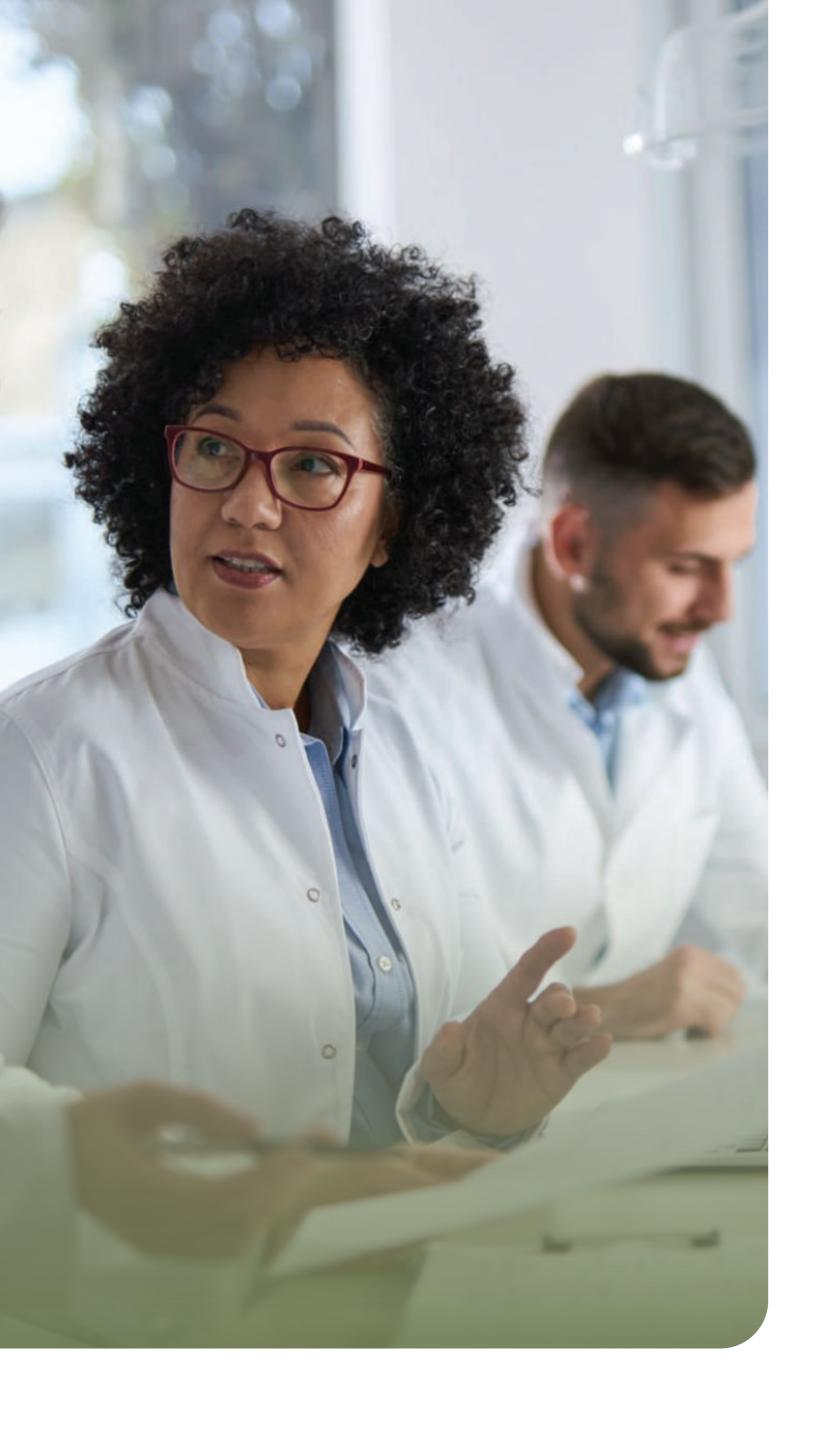

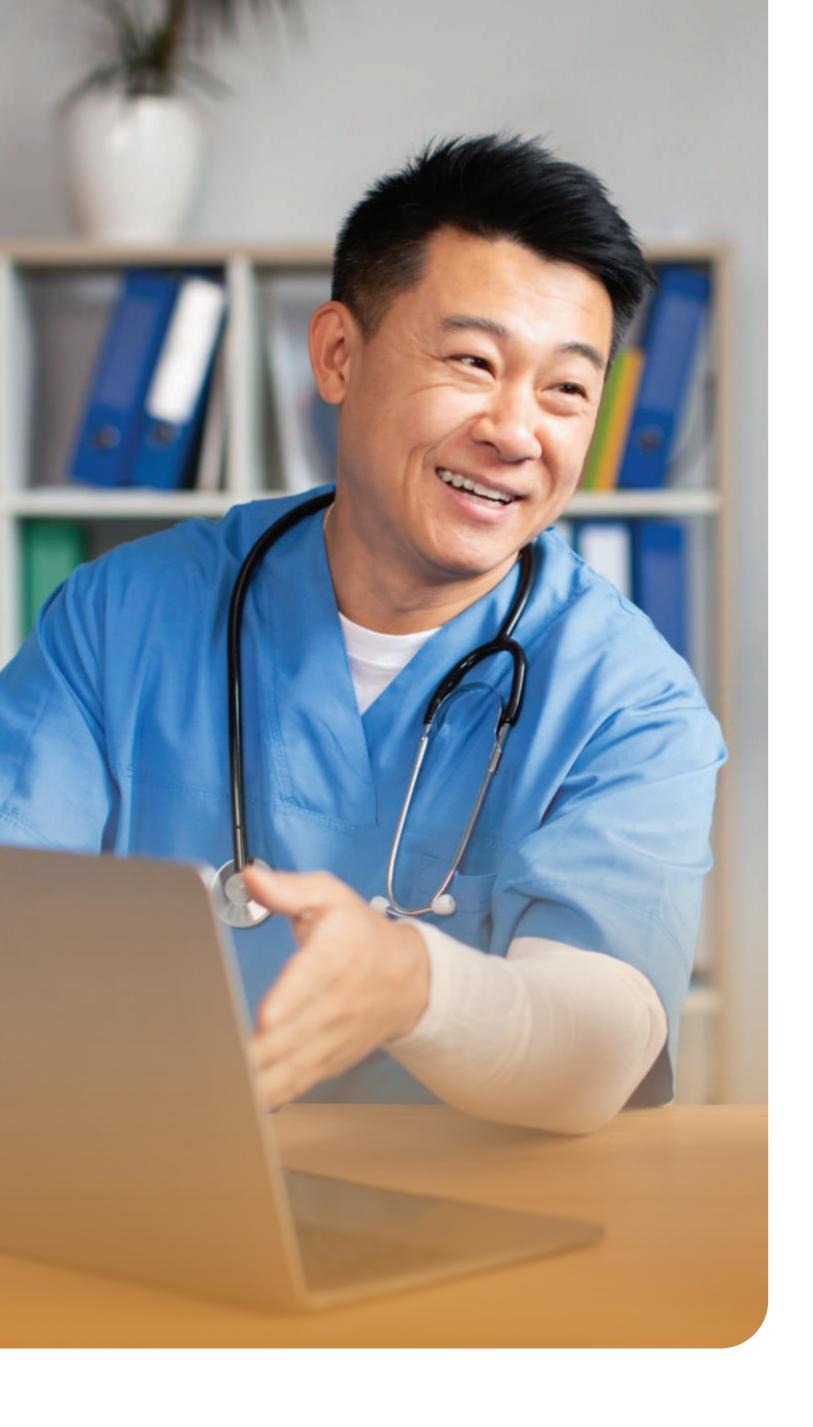
